

Catholic Priest Saves Lives Of 5, Then Rescued

A Catholic priest saved the lives
of five other priests Friday, but
had to be rescued himself in a
raging fire in the rectory of St.
Peter Claver church.

Hero of the rescue was the Rev.
Anthony A. Keil, S. S. J, pastor
of the church.

Keil, after rousing the other
priests and a carnival guest, lost
his way out of the building after
crawling on his stomach to get
under the blinding smoke.

He was pulled from the fire by
the Rev. Robert Grant, who, with
the others, was roused from his
sleep when the fire broke out.
