

# Archbishop Fills 20 Posts

The Rt. Rev. John J. Duggan, chancellor of the Catholic Archdiocese of Baltimore since 1948, has been appointed pastor of SS. Philip and James Church, Charles and Twenty-ninth streets.

The new assignment for Monsignor Duggan is one of twenty announced today by Archbishop Keough.

Monsignor Duggan, who was ordained in Rome in 1933, will be succeeded as chancellor and administrator of the Cathedral by the Rev. George L. Hopkins.

THE REV. JOSEPH P. JOSAITIS, to be pastor of St. Gregory's Church. He was pastor of St. Joseph's Church, Sykesville.

THE REV. FRANCIS J. CHILDRESS, to be administrator of St. Augustine's Church, Elkridge. He was assistant pastor of St. Elizabeth's Church.

THE REV. FRANCIS J. CONNELL, to be pastor of Holy Family Church, Randallstown. He was assistant pastor of St. Patrick's Church.

THE REV. TERENCE J. EVANS, to be pastor of St. Mary's Church, Pylesville. He was assistant pastor of St. Dominic's Church.

THE REV. AUSTIN L. HEALY, to be pastor of St. Joseph's Church, Sykesville. He was assistant pastor of Blessed Sacrament Church.

THE REV. JOHN J. HART, to be pastor of Our Lady of Mount Carmel Church, Thurmont. He was assistant pastor at St. Andrew's Church.

prelate by Pope Pius XII in 1952, will fill a vacancy that has existed since December, 1953, when the Most Rev. Lawrence J. Shehan, then Auxiliary Bishop of Baltimore, left the pastorate of SS. Philip and James to become Bishop of Bridgeport, Conn.

Father Hopkins has been serving as vice chancellor of the archdiocese and assistant rector of the Cathedral.

Monsignor Daly was director of the Catholic Charities organization when he was assigned to St. Cecelia's, Walbrook, as pastor in 1951. He was raised to the monsignori by Pope Pius with Monsignor Duggan in 1952.

Archbishop Keough said that the new appointments would be effective November 13.
