

BROOKLAWN, N. J., May 29 —Rev. Daniel F. M. Millard, pastor since 1963 of the Roman Catholic Church of St. Maurice, died Sunday at his rectory. He was 50 years old.

In World War II, Father Millard served in the Army Medical Corps. In 1943 he was assigned to perform in "The Army Play by Play," a group of playlets produced by the late John Golden with military authors and actors.

Father Millard graduated in 1947 from Holy Cross College, studied at Seton Hall University and Christ the King Seminary in Olean, N. Y., and was ordained in 1952. He was pastor of St. Bartholomew's Church in Camden before his assignment to St. Maurice's.

Survivors include three sisters, Mrs. Mary Alcock, Mrs. Helen Cahill and Mrs. Patricia McBride, and two brothers, James C. B. Millard Jr. and Charles E. F. Millard, president of the Coca-Cola Bottling Company of New York.
