## CHARGES DROPPED Hours before trial

VERO BEACH - Sexual misconduct charges against a psychiatric counselor were dropped Tuesday, just hours before he was to have

gone to trial.

William Francis "Drew" Perry III resigned as an adolescent-psychiatric counselor at Rivendell last November, about a week before he was charged with lewd and lascivious conduct with a child under the age of 15.

The teen-ager was to have been the main witness against Perry.

The prosecution could not go to trial, said Assistant State Attorney David Morgan, because the teenager was too emotionally distraught to testify. The youth also was afraid that his identity would become known in the community, Morgan said.

Morgan said that charges may be re-filed against Perry if the

teen-ager is able to testify.
